- 1.5Section 1. **FACTUAL AND OBJECTIVE INSTRUCTION FOR STUDENTS;**
- 1.6**CRITICAL RACE THEORY.**
- 1.7A school district must ensure instruction for students is factual, objective, and aligned
- 1.8to the kindergarten through grade 12 curriculum standards. A school district or public school
- 1.9may not require instruction relating to critical race theory in required curriculum. For
- 1.10purposes of this section, "critical race theory" means a practice of examining the role of
- 1.11race and racism in society, the social construction of race and institutionalized racism, and
- 1.12how race intersects with identity, systems, and policies.
- 1.13**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
