14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

  or intentionally undermine any particular religion,
  nonreligious faith or religious perspective;

10 2. The right to an unbiased education that does not endorse, 11 favor or promote socialism, communism or Marxism and that is free 12 from anti-American bias; and

3. The right to an unbiased learning environment that is free
from the display of flags or propaganda of any organization or
symbol of socialism, communism, Marxism or anti-American sentiment.

B. Each institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall establish a Safe Campus Committee to be composed of at least seven (7) members. The committee shall be composed of students who are enrolled full time in the institution, full-time faculty employed by the institution, members of the institution's administration and community representatives.

C. Students enrolled in an institution of higher education and faculty employed by an institution of higher education may report violations of the rights provided for in subsection A of this

section to the Safe Campus Committee. Reports may be made in a
 manner that protects the identity of the accuser from retribution.

D. The Safe Campus Committee shall create a due process plan
for students and faculty that includes, at a minimum, the following:

Designation of a hotline or email address to submit reports
of violations of the rights provided for in subsection A of this

8 2. Procedures for investigating and implementing punishment for9 false accusations;

Procedures for reporting to law enforcement suspected
 violations that may constitute criminal activity or reasonably have
 the potential to endanger campus safety;

4. A requirement that reported violations be investigated by
 the Safe Campus Committee in a timely manner and that individuals
 involved in the reported violations be notified of the committee's
 findings; and

17 5. A procedure for the Safe Campus Committee to hear appeals of18 the committee's findings.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

20 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
